  - a. Nebuchadnezzar's dream and request (verses 1-13)
  
  - b. Daniel's prayer and praise (verses 14-23)
  
  - c. The interpretation of the dream (verses 27-45)
  
  - d. The king's response (verses 46-49)
  
3. Scan Daniel 3. What thought, phrase or verse from Chapter Three particularly speaks to you today?
  - a. Summarize what Daniel 3 reveals to you about God.
  
  
  - b. What can you apply to your life from the example of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego?

3. Scan Daniel 6. Record one observation or discovery you made from this chapter about:
  - a. King Darius
  
  - b. The presidents and princes
  
  - c. Daniel
  
  - d. God

2. Scan Daniel 8. What stands out to you about the prophetic visions in this chapter?
  - a. How does verse 27 affect you today?
  
3. Scan Daniel 9. In what specific way does Daniel's prayer in Chapter Nine minister to you?
  - a. Recall what the following phrases mean:
    - (1.) *for thou art greatly beloved* (verse 23b)
    - (2.) *seventy weeks are determined upon thy people* (verse 24a)
    - (3.) *in the midst of the week he (the Antichrist) shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease* (verse 27b)

**FIFTH DAY:** Daniel 10-12

2. Scan Daniel 11. In what way does the exact fulfillment of the prophecies of Daniel 11:1-35 impress you?
  - a. Which prophecy in verses 36-45 particularly captures your attention?
  - b. How has the study of Daniel 11 influenced your faith?
  
3. Scan Daniel 12. With Chapter Twelve in mind write your reaction to the following phrases:
  - a. *a time of trouble, such as never was . . . and at that time thy people shall be delivered* (verse 1)
  - b. *everlasting life...and everlasting contempt* (verse 2)
  - c. *shine . . . as the stars* (verse 3)
  - d. Choose another phrase from verses 4-13 that especially speaks to you and write it here.
